Anyone who takes part in a WYS ON SHOW on stage is allowed to get one of the special neckers. They have the Gang Show Logo on the point. These can be purchased at a cost of £3.00. If you would like to get one, there is a form to complete so that we can get them ordered. Neckers will be distributed at the show party in January 2010.

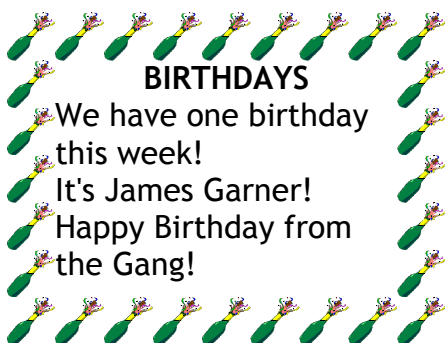
